PSYCHOMETRY EVALUATION

Psychometry evaluation of our pupils was a 3 day event, as specified in our 2nd term calendar, Nobelova Gradani carried out this exercise. Their evaluation was drawn from the Medifield tests. So all pupils who underwent the Medifield Tests were evaluated.

However, for pupil(s) who missed the Medifield test and for our new pupils, we have rescheduled them for the Medifield test, scheduled for 23rd March 2022. After which the results will be escalated to Nobelova Gradani for evaluation. And subsequently, our pupils will also undergo the psychometry evaluation.

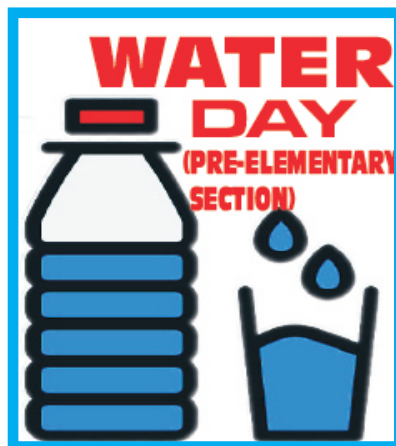
